

The Oliver N. King Honorary Scholarship for Veterans

One \$2,000 scholarship will be awarded annually to a veteran seeking new skills in order to be more competitive in the job market. The one-time \$2,000 award may be used for part- or full-time undergraduate or graduate courses toward an accredited degree or certificate program.

About Oliver N. King

Oliver N. King is a native of Jefferson Davis County, Mississippi and a 1944 graduate of Petal High School in Petal, Mississippi. King married Kathryn Diane Horne in 1951 and has three children (Sylvia, Peggy, and Douglas), six grand- and 4 great grand-children.

Mr. King believed in helping others. He began his 33-year career at the Veterans Administration as a personnel management specialist in 1947. In February of 1949 when in need of a loan for a used car, he went to the Veterans Administration Employees (Jackson, Mississippi) Federal Credit Union and was actually hired, that day, as the credit union's new Treasurer. The credit union consisted of one black book and a small metal cash box. He served as the Treasurer from February 1949 to September 1951 and from 1955 to 1980. He also served on the credit union's supervisory committee from 1952 to 1954.

King was instrumental in bringing the credit union into the computer age in 1978 and was appointed manager of the credit union on January 1, 1981. He introduced several new products and services—including Christmas Club Accounts, IRAs, and Share Draft (Checking) Accounts—and led the credit union through two data processing conversions (from ledger to banking machine to computer) before his retirement on September 30, 1990.

Mr. King volunteered for several organizations including Mothers Against Drunk Driving (MADD), Mississippi Baptist Hospital, and the National Association of Retired Federal Employees (NARFE) where he received numerous awards including "Most Outstanding Volunteer." He was also a member of the Mississippi Credit Union Managers Association—serving one year as president.

King has served on the Magnolia Federal Credit Union board of directors since 1991, was inducted into the Mississippi Credit Union Association Hall of Fame in 2005 and, in 2012 he was inducted into the Credit Union House of Leaders in Washington, D.C.

Oliver King firmly believes that "when I help someone up the hill of life, I too, am closer to the top." And at his retirement he said, "I feel I have now reached the top."

Purpose

The purpose of this scholarship is to provide financial assistance to a veteran who is a member of Magnolia Federal Credit Union in good standing, who has exhausted government aid, or who might not otherwise have the financial means to further his/her post-high school education.

Eligibility

Applicants must meet all of the eligibility requirements listed below and submit the completed application **postmarked on or before** May 30th to: ATTN: Marketing; Magnolia Federal Credit Union; 240 Briarwood Drive; Jackson, MS 39206. Scholarship winner will be notified on or before July 1. - 1. Must be a member of Magnolia Federal Credit Union in good standing.
- 2. Must demonstrate financial need.
- 3. Must have a high school diploma or GED.
- 4. Must agree to authorize Magnolia FCU to publicize your scholarship award, if you are selected.
- 5. Must be enrolled or accepted for enrollment to an eligible program.

Required Materials

- 1. A copy of the veteran's honorable discharge or a letter from the commanding officer certifying current Guard or Reserve status.
- 2. Official college transcripts for all courses attempted and any degrees or certificates awarded. If post-secondary credits amount to less than 12 credit hours and high school diploma was awarded within the past five years, a high school transcript must be provided. Transcripts must be in the 4.0 grade scale or if in a different system, translated to the 4.0 scale.
- 3. A complete and signed copy of the applicant's 1040 tax form must be enclosed. It will be used to verify financial need.
- 4. A copy of the applicant's Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA).
- 5. Acceptance letter or a letter stating current student status from an accredited program.
- 6. A resume detailing military duty and awards, volunteer activities, community services, and jobs held during the past four years.
